The team presented the case study on 'Minimizing Weld distortion in Metro Bogie Frame Manufacturing'.

"SPARTAN" team of BEML, Bangalore complex led by Sri Niranjan Kumar Singh, Sr. Manager along with team members S/S Manoranjan Das, Asst. Manager & C Vasudevan; Manager presented the Quality Circle project based on six sigma techniques to ensure 'Zero Defects' manufacturing of Metro Car Bogie. Process optimization was carried out using Taguchi Methodology. With this, bogie frames are manufactured at BEML on par with international standard which has been approved by Delhi Metro Rail Corporation. It has helped in substantial saving on import cost and made BEML self-reliant in Metro Bogie manufacturing as a part of "Make in India" initiative.

It may be recalled that QC team from BEML, Bangalore Complex had participated in **International Quality Circle competition** and won "Distinction Award" in 2013 at **Taipei**, "Silver Award" in 2014 at **Colombo** and "Gold Award" in 2016 at **Bangkok**.
