1. SUBMISSION OF BIDS:

MODE OF SUBMISSION OF BID:-

- (A) (i) The bidder shall submit the bid in Electronic Mode only i.e. in www.tenderwizard.com/OPTCL portal. The bidder must ensure that the bids are received in the specified website of the OPTCL by the date and time indicated in the Tender notice.
 - (ii) Bids submitted by telex/telegram will not be accepted.
 - (iii) The OPTCL reserves the right to reject any bid, which is not submitted in electronic mode and according to the instruction, stipulated above.

(A-I) PARTICIPATION IN e-TENDER:-

ACQUSITION OF DIGITAL SIGNATURE CERTIFICATE

- (i) For all the users it is mandatory to procure the Digital Signatures of Class III only.
- (ii) Bidders / Suppliers are requested to follow the below steps for registration.

(A-2) REGISTRATION IN TENDER WIZARD PORTAL

- (i) Log in www.tenderwizard.com/OPTCL Click "Register", fill the online registration Form.
- (ii) Payment for an amount of Rs. **2290**/- shall be made to KSEDCL, Bangalore for vendor registration in tender wizard portal in **e-payment** mode only.

(iii) As soon as the verification is being done the e-tender user id will be enabled/provided.

(A-3) ON LINE REQUEST FOR e-tender DOCUMENTS.

In the event of the specified date for the submission of bids being declared a holiday for OPTCL, the bids will be received on the next working day as per the time indicated in tender notification.

(ii) OPTCL may, at its discretion, extend this deadline for submission of bids by amending the Bidding Documents in accordance with ITB for the reasons specified therein at any time prior to opening of, in which case all rights and obligations of Employer and bidders will thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.

(2-A) LATE BIDS

- (i) Soft part of the bid will not be uploaded on the portal after expiry of submission time and the bidder shall not be permitted to submit the same by any other mode. In such case, even if the bidder has submitted the specific documents in hard copy in original (viz., bid security, tender cost & any other document) within the stipulated deadline, its bid shall be considered as late bid. The hard copy submitted [specific documents (viz., bid security, tender cost.)] shall be returned unopened to the bidder.
- (ii) Hard copy of the bid security of the bid received by OPTCL after the deadline for submission of bid prescribed by the GTCC will be considered as late bid even if the bidder has uploaded the soft part of the bid within the stipulated deadline. In such a case, the soft part of the bid uploaded on the portal shall be sent unopened to "Archive" and shall not be considered at all any further.

(2-B) MODIFICATION AND WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS:-

- (i) Bidder may modify or withdraw its bids through the relevant provisions on the portal www.tenderwizard.com/OPTCL up to due date and time of submission of bid indicated in tender notification.
 - (ii) The Bidder's modifications shall be done and submitted as follows:

(iii) Bidder may withdraw its bid through the relevant provisions of portal only.

(iv)No bid shall be modified/ withdrawn subsequent to the dead line for submission of bids. Withdrawal/modification of bid before the expiry of bid validity shall result forfeiture of Bidder's bid security. 3. Tenders shall be in single Part

The Tenderers are required to submit the tenders in single part in sealed covers.

4. Opening of Bids.

- (a) The tender shall be opened in the office of the SR.GENERAL MANAGER(S&S), in presence of such of the Tenderers or their authorized representatives (limited to one person only) on the due date of opening of tender and after scrutiny of the technical particulars and other commercial terms, clarifications as may be required, shall be sought for from the bidders. The Tenderers shall be allowed 15 days time for such activity.
- (b) On receipt of technical clarification the bids shall be reviewed/evaluated and those not in conformity with the technical Specification/qualifying experience, shall be rejected. If any of the technical proposals requires modification to make them comparable, discussion will be held with the participating bidders.
- (c) The bidders are required to furnish sufficient information to the Purchaser to establish their qualification/capability to manufacture and/or supply the materials/perform the work. Such information shall include details of bidders experience, its financial, managerial and technical capabilities.
- (d) The bidders are also required to furnish details of availability of appropriate technical staff and capability to perform after sales service where applicable. The above information shall be considered during the first stage of scrutiny and evaluation of bids
- (e) The price bids of the technically and otherwise acceptable bids, shall only be evaluated as per the norms applicable in terms of this Specification.

5. Purchaser's Right Regarding Alteration of Quantities Tendered.

The Purchaser may alter the quantities of materials/equipment at the time of placing orders. Initially the Purchaser may place order for lesser quantity with full freedom to place extension orders for further quantity under similar terms and conditions of the original orders. Order may also be split among more than one Tenderer for any particular item if considered necessary in the interest of the Purchaser.

6. Procedure & Opening Time of Tenders:

Tenders will be opened in the office of the SR. GENERAL MANAGER(S&S), on the specified date and time in presence of such of the Tenderers or their authorized representatives (limited to one person only) in case of each bidders who may desire to be present, at the time of opening the bids. The SR.GENERAL MANAGER(S&S) or his authorized representatives will, on opening each bid, read aloud the name of the bidder. He shall also read aloud the attested and un-attested corrections and shall record the number of such corrections on each page of the technical bid over his dated initials and also initial all such corrections.

7. <u>Bidder's Liberty to Deviate from Specification</u>:

The Tenderer may deviate from the Specification while quoting if in his opinion such deviation is in the line with the manufacturers standard practice and conducive to a better and more economical offer. All

such deviations should however be clearly indicated giving full justifications for such deviation. (Read with Clause-9, Section-II of the Specification).

8. Eligibility for Submission of Bids.

Tenderers who have purchased the Specification from the office or downloaded from the official website of OPTCL & deposited the tender cost while submitting the tender will only be considered.

9. Purchaser's Right to Accept/Reject Bids.

The purchaser reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reasons what so ever if it is in the interest of OPTCL under the existing circumstances. (Read with Clause-10, Section-II of the Specification).

10. Mode of Submission of Bids.

- (A) Soft copy of the bid shall be uploaded through the portal www.tenderwizard.com/OPTCL on or before the online submission time and date as stipulated in the bidding document. DD towards Tender cost & DD/BG towards Bid Security (except bid sheets) must be received by OPTCL at the address specified not later than the time and date stated in the tender notification. 11(i) Earnest Money Deposit.

The tender shall be accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit of value specified in the notice inviting tenders against each lot/bid. Tenders without the required E.M.D. will be rejected outright.

The earnest money deposit shall be furnished in one of the following forms subject to the conditions mentioned below:

- (b) Bank Guarantee from any nationalized/scheduled Bank strictly as per enclosed proforma vide Annexure-VI to be executed on non-judicial stamp paper of appropriate value worth 29/- to be accompanied by the confirmation letter of the issuing Bank.

The validity of the E.M.D. Bank Guarantee shall be 240 days from the date of opening of tender, failing which the tender will be liable for rejection.

- (i) No adjustment towards Earnest Money Deposit shall be permitted against any outstanding amount with the OPTCL.
- (ii) In the case of un-successful Tenderer the Earnest Money will be refunded Immediately after the tender is decided. In the case of successful tenderer, EMD will be refunded only after furnishing of

- security money referred to at Clause-19 of section . II. Suits if any, arising out of this Clause shall be filed in a Court of law to which the jurisdiction of high court of Orissa extends.
- (iii) Earnest Money will be forfeited if the Tenderer fails to accept the letter of intent and /or purchase orders issued in his favour.

Tenders not accompanied by Earnest Money shall be summarily rejected.

12. Validity of the Bids

The tenders should be kept valid for a period of 180 days from the date of opening of the tender as notified in the tender notice failing which the tenders will be rejected.

13. **PRICE** Tenderers are requested to quote FIRM price only.

14. Revision of Tender Price By Bidders

- (a) After opening of tenders and within the validity period, no reduction or Enhancement in price will be entertained. If there is any change in price, the tender shall stand rejected and E.M.D. deposited shall be forfeited. In case of bidders who are exempted from depositing E.M.D. and who revise their price within the validity period, the bids for similar items against subsequent tender call notice of OPTCL, may not be considered.
- (b) If required, the Tenderers may be asked to extend the validity period of bids under the same terms and conditions as per the original tender except for the change in delivery period, In such an event the Tenderers are free to change any or all conditions of their bids.

15. Tenderers to be fully Conversant with the Clauses of the Specification.

Tenderers are expected to be fully conversant with the meaning of all the Clauses of the Specification before submitting their tenders. In case of doubt regarding the meaning of any Clause the Tenderer may seek clarification in writing from the Sr.General Manager, Stores Circle OPTCL, Bhubaneswar. This however, does not entitle the Tenderer to ask for time beyond due date fixed for receipt of tender.

- iii) In the event of discrepancy or arithmetical error in the schedule of price, the decision of the Purchaser shall be final and binding on the Tenderer.
- iv) For evaluation the price mentioned in words shall be taken if there is any difference in figure and words in the price bid.
- v) Notice inviting tender shall form part of this Specification.

The price bids of the technically and otherwise acceptable bids shall only be evaluated. The price bids of others (along with E.M.D. if any) shall be returned to the bidders unopened

SECTION - II

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT (G.T.C.C)

1. Scope of the Contract

The scope of the contract shall be to Supply of various types of LED light fittings for OPTCL, Bhubaneswar, Odisha.(Make: Philips/Havells/CG)and rendering service in accordance with the enclosed **Technical Specification** and bill of quantity/materials.

2.0 **Definition of Terms**

For the purpose of this Specification and General Terms & Conditions of Contract (G.T.C.C.) the following words shall have the meanings hereby indicated, except where otherwise described or defined.

- 2.1 % Purchaser+ shall mean the Sr.General Manager, Stores Circle OPTCL, Bhubaneswar for & on behalf of ORISSA POWER TRANSMISSION CORPORATION LTD., Bhubaneswar.
- 2.2 % The Engineer+shall mean the engineer appointed by the Purchaser for the purpose of this contract.
- 2.2 % Rurchaser of Representative+ shall mean any person or persons or consulting firm appointed and remunerated by the Purchaser to supervise, inspect, test and examine workmanship and materials of the equipment to be supplied.
- 2.3 %The Contractor+shall mean the Bidder whose bid has been accepted by the Purchaser and shall include the Biddersqexecutives, Administrators, Successors and permitted assignees.
- 2.4 %Equipment+shall mean and include all machinery, apparatus, Materials, articles to be provided under the contract by the Contractor.
- 2.5 %Contract Price+ shall mean the sum named in or calculated in accordance with the provisions of the contract as the %Contract Price+which shall include packing, forwarding, freight, insurance excise duty, sales tax, Octroi and other taxes and duties as applicable at the time of opening of bids.
- 2.6 %General Conditions+shall mean these General Terms and Conditions of Contract.
- 2.7 %The Specification+shall mean the Specification annexed to or issued with G.T.C.C. and shall include the schedules & drawings attached thereto as well as all samples and pattern, if any.
- 2.8 %Month+shall mean %Calendar month+.
- 2.9 Writing+shall include any manuscript, type written, printed or other statement re-production in any visible form and whether under seal or under hand.
- 2.10 % O.R. Destination Costs+shall mean the cost of equipment and material at the consignees stores. The cost is exclusive of Excise duty, Sales Tax and other Local Taxes, but is inclusive of packing, forwarding and insurance and freight charges.
- 2.11 The term %Contract documents+ shall mean and include G.T.C.C., Specifications, Schedules, Drawings, Form of Tender, Covering Letter, Schedule of Price of the final successful bidder any special conditions applicable to the particular contract, Specifications and drawings and the purchase order & the agreement to be entered into.
- 2.12 Terms and Conditions not herein defined shall have the same meaning as are assigned to them in the Indian Contract Act, failing that, in the Odisha General Clauses Act.

3. **Manner of Execution**

All equipments supplied under the contract shall be manufactured in the manner set out in the Specification or where not set out, to the reasonable satisfaction of the Purchasers representative.

4. <u>Inspection and Testing</u>

- i) The contractor will conduct the statuary inspection by the Electrical inspector from ELBO, Bhubaneswar at their own cost after completion of installation, commissioning & testing of Elevator. The required inspection fee will deposited by the firm accordingly.
- Where the contract provides for test on the Premises of the Contractor or of any of his Sub-Contractors, the Contractor shall provide such assistance, labour, materials, electricity, fuel and instruments as may be required or as may be reasonably demanded by the Purchaseros representative to carryout such test effectively & efficiently. The Contractor is required to produce Routine Test Certificate before offering their materials for inspection.
- After completion of the tests, the Purchasers representative shall forward the test results to the Purchaser. If the test results are satisfactory, the purchaser shall communicate the same to the Contractor in writing. The Contractor shall provide at least three copies of the test certificates to the Purchaser.
- iv) The Purchaser has the right to have the tests carried out at his own cost by an independent agency whenever there is a dispute regarding the quality of supply.

5. Training Facilities

The Contractor shall provide all possible facilities for training of Purchasers Technical personnel, where applicable when deputed by the Purchaser for acquiring first hand knowledge in operation of the elevator and for its proper operation and maintenance in service if required.

6. **Rejection of Materials**

In the event any of the materials/equipment supplied by the Contractor is found defective due to faulty design, bad workmanship, bad materials used or otherwise not in conformity with the requirements of the Specification, the Purchaser shall either reject the materials/equipment or ask the Contractor in writing to rectify the same. The Contractor on receipt of such notification shall either rectify or replace the defective equipment free of cost of the Purchaser. If the Contractor fails to do so, the Purchaser may:-

- (a) As its option, replace or rectify such defective equipment and recover the extra costs so involved from the Contractor plus fifteen percent and /or.
- (b) Terminate the contract for balance work/supplies, with enforcement of penalty Clause as per contract for the un-delivered goods and with forfeiture of performance Guarantee/Composite Bank Guarantee.
- (c) Acquire the defective equipment/materials at reduced price, considered equitable under the circumstances.

7. Experience of Bidders:

The bidders should furnished information regarding experience particularly on the following points:-

- i) Name of the Manufacture.
- ii) Standing of the firm and manufacture of equipment quoted:
- iii) Description of equipment similar to the quoted, supplied and installed during the last four years with the name(s) of the party(s) to whom supplies were made:

- vi) If the manufacturer is having collaboration with another firm(s) details regarding the same.
- vii) A list of Purchase orders executed during the last four years along with users certificate.

Bids may not be considered if the past manufacturing experience is found to be un-satisfactory or is of less than 4 years on the date of opening of the bid.

8. **Language and Measures**

All documents pertaining to the contract including Specifications, Schedule, Notices, Correspondence, Operating & Maintenance instructions, Drawings or any other writing shall be written in English language. The metric system of measurement shall be used exclusively in this contract.

9. **Deviation from Specification**

It is in the interest of the Tenderers to study the Specification, drawing etc. specified in the tender schedule thoroughly before tendering so that, if any deviations are made by the Tenderers the same are prominently brought out on a separate sheet under heading %Deviations+.

A list of deviation shall be enclosed with the Tender. Unless deviation in scope, technical and commercial stipulations are specifically mentioned in the list of deviations, it shall be presumed that the Tenderer has accepted all the conditions stipulated in the tender Specification, not withstanding any exemptions mentioned therein.

10. Right to Reject/Accept Any Tender

The Purchaser reserves the right either to reject or to accept any or all tenders if the situation so warrants in the interest of the Purchaser. Orders may also be split up between different Tenderers on individual merits of the Tenderer. The Purchaser has exclusive right to alter the quantities of materials at the time of placing final Purchase order. After placing of the order, the Purchaser may defer the delivery of the materials. It may be clearly understood by the Tenderer that the Purchaser need not, assign any reason for the above action(s).

11. Contractor to inform himself fully

The Contractor shall examine the instructions to Tenderers, General Conditions of contract, Specification and the Schedules of Quantity and delivery to satisfy himself as to all terms and conditions and

circumstances affecting the contract price. He shall quote price(s) according to his own views on these matters and understand that additional allowances except as otherwise provided therein will be levied. The Purchaser shall not be responsible for any misunderstanding or incorrect information obtaining by the Contractor other than the information given to the Contractor in writing by the Purchaser.

12. Patent Rights Etc.

The Contractor shall indemnify the Purchaser against all claims, actions, suits and proceedings for the infringement or alleged infringement of any patent design or copy right protected either in the country of origin or in India by the use of any equipment/ materials supplied by the Contractor. But such indemnity shall not cover any use of the equipment, other than for the purpose indicated by or reasonably to be inferred from the Specification.

13. **Delivery**

- (a) Time being essence of the contract, the equipment shall be supplied within the delivery date specified in the contract. The Purchaser, however, reserves the right to reschedule the delivery and change the destination if required. The delivery period shall be reckoned from the date of placing the Letter or Intent/Purchase order as may be specified in the Purchase order.
- (b) i) The desired delivery including installation & commissioning period shall not exceed more than 3 (Three)months.
 - ii) The quantity offered for inspection should tally with the lots prescribed for delivery in the purchase order.

14. Despatch instructions.

- i) The materials should be securely packed and dispatched directly to the consignee at the Contractors risk by Lorry Transport only.
 - ii) Loading & Unloading of Ordered Materials.

It will be the sole responsibility of the Contractor for loading and unloading & stacking of materials both at the factory site and at the destination store. The Purchaser shall have no responsibility on this account.

15. <u>Contractor's Default Liability</u>.

- i) The Purchaser may, upon written notice of default to the Contractor, terminate the contract in circumstanced detailed hereunder.
 - (a) If in the judgement of the Purchaser, the Contractor fails to make delivery of equipment within the time specified in the contract or within the period for which extension has been granted by the Purchaser in writing in response to written request of the Contractor.

- (b) If in the judgment of the Purchaser, the Contractor fails to comply with any of the provisions of this contract.
- ii) In the event Purchaser terminates the contract in whole or in part as provided in Clause-15(i) of this section, the Purchaser reserves the right to purchase upon such terms and in such a manner as he may deem appropriate equipment/ material similar to those terminated and the Contractor will be liable to the Purchaser for any additional costs for such similar equipment and/or for penalty for delay as defined in Clause-23 of this section until such reasonable time as may be required for the final supply of equipment.
- In the event the Purchase does not terminate the contract as provided in Clause 15(i) of this Section, Contractor shall continue executing the contract, in which case he shall be liable to the Purchaser for penalty for delay as set out in Clause-23 of this Section until the equipment is accepted. This shall be based only on written request of the supplier and written willingness of Purchaser.

16. Force Majeure:

The Contractor shall not be liable for any penalty for delay or for failure to perform the contract for reasons of force Majeure such as acts of God, acts of the public enemy, acts of Govt., Fires, Floods, Epidemics, Quarantine restrictions, strikes, Freight Embargo, provided that the Contractor shall within ten (10) days from the beginning of such delay notify the Purchaser in writing of the cause of delay, upon which, the Purchaser shall verify the facts and grant such extension as facts justify.

17. Extension of Time.

If the delivery of equipment/materials is delayed due to reasons beyond the control of the Contractor, the Contractor shall without delay give notice to the Purchaser in writing of his claim for an extension of time. The Purchaser on receipt of such notice may agree to extend the contract delivery date as may be reasonable but without prejudice to other terms and conditions of the contract.

18. Guarantee Period.

- The stores covered by this Specification should be Guaranteed for satisfactory operation and against defects in design, materials and workmanship for a period of at least 24 (twentyfour) months from the date of commissioning. The above Guarantee Certificate shall be furnished in triplicate to the purchaser or his approval. Any defect noticed during this period should be rectified by the Contractor free of cost to the Purchaser provided such defects are due to faulty design, bad workmanship or bad materials used, upon written notice from the Purchaser.
- ii) Equipment/material failed or found defective during Guarantee period shall have to be guaranteed after repair/replacement for a further period of 24 months from the date of commissioning or 30 months from the date of receipt at the Stores after such repair/replacement which ever is earlier.

Date of delivery as used in this Clause shall mean the date on which the materials are received in OPTCL stores in good condition, which are released for despatch by the Purchaser after due inspection.

19. Bank Guarantee towards Security Deposit, 100% Payment and performance Guarantee.

A Composite Bank Guarantee as per the proforma enclosed at Annexure-VII of the specification for 10%(Ten percent) of the total FOR Destination cost of the order, shall be furnished from any Nationalised/ Scheduled Bank to the office of Sr.General Manager, Stores Circle OPTCL, Bhubaneswar within 15 (Fifteen) days of issue of purchase order. The Bank Guarantee shall be executed on non-judicial stamp paper worth of Rs.29/- or as applicable, as per the prevalent rules, valid for a period of 20 months from the last date of stipulated delivery period for scrutiny and acceptance, failing which the order will be liable for cancellation without any further written notice. The said Bank Guarantee should be accompanied or followed by a confirmation letter from the concerned Bank, before the Bank Guarantee is accepted and all concerned intimated. If the Contractor fails to complete the work within the completion period schedule specified in the contract including delivery time extension, if any, granted thereto, the Purchaser shall recover from the Contractor penalty for a sum of one half of one percent (0.5 per cent) of the Ex-works price of the undelivered equipment for each calendar week of delay or any part thereof. For this purpose the date of receipted challans shall be reckoned as the date of delivery.
